OUR HISTORY

Paws Crossed Animal Rescue was born from the community, for the community, in order to bring back the only **true no-kill** rescue to Westchester County. Paws Crossed's history began when the previous organization in Elmsford closed their doors in September 2015 and consolidated all assets to their other location in Orange County, NY. Immediately, rescue came to a deafening halt, all community programming stopped and the property was in danger of being sold commercially. The community was understandably upset (there had been a rescue in Elmsford since 1932) and demanded a true no-kill return to Westchester. The community of Greenburgh discovered a deed restriction requiring this property to only be transferred to another animal rescue or to be used as a municipal property. From this 11th hour discovery, Paws Crossed, a completely new organization, was born! We were incorporated in August 2015 and received our not for profit status in October 2015. After 10 months of negotiations, the Town of Greenburgh received the property back, and we were immediately gifted the building and property. We signed in June 2016, and opened to the public in September 2016. We have been a whirlwind of lifesaving activity ever since!

Volunteer Program:

Community Kibble:

Community Kibble is a free program to help those that cannot afford food and supplies for their pets. There are no eligibility requirements, the program works off of the honor system!

Seniors for Seniors:

It is well known the importance that pets play in our lives, regardless of how old we are - or how old our pets are. The companionship a pet can offer is unmatched and we believe that everyone deserves a chance to give and receive unconditional love! Our Seniors for Seniors Adoption Program helps bring wonderful senior orphaned pets into loving homes!

Pets for Patriots:

This program highlights some of the longer-stay pets who are searching for their hero, while also helping a veteran find a new best friend.

Free Pet Preventative Clinics:

Through grants and a partnership with Banfield Foundation, these clinics help members of our community that need assistance with vaccines, flea and tick medications, nail trimmings, ear cleanings etc. So far we have assisted over 140 families with their furry friends! This program helps people keep pets in their homes.



THE PROJECT



The current and largest chapter of our “There’s No Place Like Home” Capital Campaign is the re-constructing of a portion of the building that has been dormant since the previous organization closed its doors in 2015. This area has two floors that equal approximately 5,900 square feet and will become our brand new Adoption Center!

THE NEED



Statistics show that approximately *6.5 million* pets enter the shelter system each year. Of this

number, **2.4 million pets never make it out.** The new Adoption Center will enable us to steadily decrease this devastating statistic.

The impact of this Chapter of our ‘There’s No Place Like Home’ Campaign will be significant and life-saving for the orphaned pets, people and community that love them. This new Adoption Center will enable us to continue helping to solve the problem of staggering pet overpopulation, pet homelessness and tragically high euthanasia numbers. THE IMPACT



01 Increased Rescues and Adoptions

A new, larger Adoption Center will double our life-saving capabilities for our feline friends. Each orphaned pet that we place in a forever home, not only makes room for another pet at our Rescue, but it also makes space for another pet at our partnering shelters. That means that three lives are saved with each adoption!

02 Keeping More Pets in Their Homes

The three new “Meet and Greet” rooms will encourage people to spend more time with adoption counselors and our pets to help in finding their perfect match. This will increase time for questions and bonding, with the goal of minimizing potential frustrations in the home and decreasing return rates.

The education programming that we will be able to offer in this new space will provide invaluable information on pet ownership, training techniques and much more...helping people feel more prepared to care for their pets!

Clinic Days held at the Rescue will provide low cost services to our community, helping to break down barriers to pet ownership.

03 Happier and Healthier People

The new Adoption Center will be aesthetically pleasing to our visitors. The more people that leave our Rescue with a positive impression, the more likely that they will tell others about their experiences, causing our impact to spread even wider throughout the community and beyond.

It is known that pets are shown to reduce stress, lower blood pressure, and encourage more exercise! With increased adoptions, volunteering and programming, the community's access to our pets will promote healthier lifestyles.

04 Happier and Healthier Pets

We have been mindful of enrichment tools and engaging designs to provide the pets in our care with the mental stimulation that they need and deserve. The layout, structures and materials used in the construction of the Adoption Center have been designed to make surfaces easier to clean and sanitize. This means our pets will spend even more time in pristine conditions. In addition, our team will have more time to spend with the pets themselves.

Our new Veterinary Clinic will be on a separate air filtration system, providing a safe and secure place for our pets to recover from illness or surgery without a fear of disease spread throughout the Rescue.

With spaying and neutering made possible through our clinic, stress levels for our pets will be drastically lowered by reducing how often they have to travel. Our pets will no longer have to wait for their procedures and can be available for adoption much sooner. Aside from the benefits to our pets, this will save the time and resources that it takes to travel and coordinate appointments.

Our four new cat rooms will give our cats more opportunities to co-exist with their fellow felines, providing them with much needed companionship and exercise!

05 Targeted Community Programming

We are completely invested in enhancing our current programming and creating new ones that will benefit people both physically and emotionally.

Our new Community Room will provide a welcoming environment for programming that will be targeted at creating an informed and pet savvy community.



06 Increased Partnerships with Like-Minded Organizations

We strive to be part of the bigger solution rather than simply putting a “band-aid” on the problem of pet overpopulation. Numerous transport partners that we work with are not only rescuing consistently and in large numbers each month from high-kill shelters, but they are instilling spay/neuter clinics in their communities. Like us, they are also working with local governments to advocate for animal rights.
